# Diacriticals

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1. Diaeresis (chpt 3)
2. Apostrophe (ἀπό → ἀπ')
3. Accents (pitch, stress)
  - acute (ᾳτέω); grave (θεὸς); circumflex (ἄγνῶς)
  - debate: pronunciation; memorization; identification

# Apostrophe

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ἀπό → ἀπ'

# Accents

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1. Acute: αἰτέω
2. Grave: θεὸς
3. Circumflex: ἀγνῶς

# Syllabification

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Dividing a word into different pieces so it can be pronounced

Two methods

- Learn rules (Appendix)
- Listen to teacher — natural for English speaker

Listen carefully when learning vocabulary

# Syllabification

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1. There is one vowel (or diphthong) per syllable.

ἀ κη κό α μεν

# Syllabification

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2. A single consonant by itself (not a cluster) goes with the following vowel.

έ ω ρά κα μεν

# Syllabification

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3. Two consecutive vowels that do not form a diphthong are divided.

ἐ θε α σά με θα

# Syllabification

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4. A consonant cluster that can not be pronounced together is divided.

ἔμ προ σθεν

# Syllabification

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5. A consonant cluster that can be pronounced together goes with the following vowel

Xρι στος

# Syllabification

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6. Double consonants are divided.

παρ ρη σί α

# Syllabification

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7. Compound words are divided where joined.

ἀντὶ χριστος

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Approximations — ἀδελφός “literally”

“The Bible says ‘brother.’”

1. “Brother”
2. Someone you are close to — “Brother” / “Sister”
3. Plural: “brothers and sisters”

Not what is *says* but what it *means*.
